Batman Arkham City GOTY edition 3.55 fix rogero 4.21+.DENVER – A Colorado judge on Tuesday issued a restraining order against President Donald Trump’s plan to send U.S. forces to the border with Mexico. Trump’s order can only be carried out by U.S. military personnel under the Uniform Code of Military Justice, according to military judge Col. Robert Burnett. State District Judge William Martinez issued a temporary restraining order preventing Trump from sending troops to the border, according to KTNV in Nevada. TRUMP SENDS F-35 FIGHTERS TO MEXICO, PUTS ALLIES TO THE TEST Martinez said he issued the order after hearing from the American Civil Liberties Union and the American Immigration Council. "The Supreme Court has long held that when the government attempts to use the military to enforce the laws of the United States, it is acting in violation of the Constitution," the judge said in the order. Trump tweeted Tuesday that the Justice Department "will file an appeal." The judge also issued an order on the Justice Department for an emergency injunction and a hearing on a preliminary injunction. The judge’s order follows a tweet sent by Trump on Monday, which called on Mexico to pay for a border wall. “This is an emergency and must be stopped,” the president tweeted. TRUMP’S BORDER WALL PROJECT GETS DRAMATIC NEW FORM: 'BIGGEST SON OF A BITCH ON EARTH' The president later tweeted that “Mexico will pay for the Wall through reimbursement/other.” The tweet came after Mexico’s president, Andres Manuel Lopez Obrador, said he would not pay for the wall. “Mexico will not pay for the wall,” he tweeted. “The decision is final,” he added. Trump has set a March 29 deadline to have a wall completed along the nearly 2,000-mile border with Mexico.
